## Enrollment Process

### All Applicants

Applications for enrollment at South Shore Charter Public School are welcome from all school-aged students who are residents of Massachusetts.

- Complete and sign the ***K-11 Application Form***
- Submit a copy of the student's birth certificate  
*A student must be five years old (5) or no older than seven years old (7) by October 31<sup>st</sup> of his or her kindergarten year*
- Submit Proof of Residency. A copy of a utility bill or copy of a lease
- Read and sign the Grades K-6 or Grades 7-12 ***Student/Parent Statement of Expectations***

### All Parents

The applicant's parent needs to write a letter to SSCPS including:

- The reasons you would like your child to attend SSCPS;
- Your thoughts on the learning style of your child to help us determine the most appropriate class placement;
- What skills and interests you, the parent, have that you would be willing to share with SSCPS.

### Applicants for Grades 7-11

- Submit a current transcript or most recent report card
- Write a letter explaining why you would like to attend SSCPS
- Complete and submit the attached ***Resume Form***

The 2012-2013 Enrollment Lottery will be held on Saturday, February 11, 2012. For applications to be eligible for the Lottery, the application package must include all the items listed in the checklist above and received by the Enrollment Office no later than February 8, 2012. No faxed copies will be accepted. It is the responsibility of the applying family to be sure the application has been received by the school's office.

The Enrollment Lottery is a public meeting and applicants are welcome to attend. During the lottery, applicant cards are organized by Sibling, Resident, and Non-resident. *Siblings are students who have the same legal or biological parent as a currently enrolled student.* As names are drawn, and read aloud, a number is assigned to each name. A list for each grade will be made for immediate acceptance and a Waitlist in the order names are drawn. Applicant families may "Opt Out" of having their child's name read by notifying the Enrollment Office.

Once accepted, each student and their family will be required to attend an official Enrollment Registration which may include Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Screening, ELL Screening, Learning Services Questionnaire, and a Diagnostic Assessment in English and Math for all new students entering grades 7-11. All 9<sup>th</sup> grade students and any new 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grade students are required to attend a mandatory Summer Institute and parents are required to attend a mandatory parent night in the spring.
